1 Reason for granting permission:

Condition 4 required details of a suitably qualified chartered engineer with membership of the appropriate professional body to be appointed to inspect,

approve and monitor the critical elements of both permanent and temporary basement construction works throughout their duration, to ensure compliance with the design which has been checked and approved by a building control body. Symmetrys Limited have been appointed. The submitted details and appointment letter confirm that the chartered structural engineers have the relevant qualifications which comply with the requirements of Camden Planning Guidance, including CEng and MIStructE.

Details have been submitted to discharge condition 5 demonstrating how trees to be retained shall be protected during construction work. The Council's Trees and Landscaping Officer has assessed the information and confirmed the details are considered sufficient to demonstrate that the trees to be retained will be adequately protected throughout development in line with BS5837:2012, and that condition 5 can be discharged.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed during the determination of the original consent (reference 2017/4287/P). The planning history of the site has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such, the submitted details are considered sufficient to discharge conditions 4 and 5 and are in accordance with policies A2, A3, A5, D1 and D2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

2 You are advised that all conditions relating to planning permission granted on 06/12/2017 under reference 2017/4287/P which need details to be submitted, have been approved.
