- 1. The hours of use of the terrace to be no more than 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday only. The applicant has offered 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, but this is not acceptable to families living all around for obvious reasons. Any breach should lead to use of that terrace being suspended for 1 year.
- 2. The 1st floor terrace to have planting installed throughout, subject to exacting standards of maintenance. The reason for this is the deep, enclosed space that it occupies, causing every sound to echo and carry to the flats at Aria House alongside.
- 3. The 1st floor terrace to have no smoking permitted at any time. The reason for this is the proximity of residential windows in the enclosed space.
- 4. No furniture to be permitted on the 1st floor terrace.
