One of the first things that they have overlooked are chimney flues. The old Victorian property 32 Winchester road chimney flues should not be destroyed as neighbours still use their fireplace, but the builders hired by the developers almost got rid of the flues due to ignorance and lack of communication with the surveyor, architect and consideration of people who live downstairs. •The impact of noise from building equipment - it's been going on since January 2018 -with the new extension construction in plan for how long the noise will continue? For how long the residents especially the ones being affected directly can be subjected to constant noise by law? Noise - drilling, banging from 8-5pm everyday and Saturday even after 1pm. •The boiler and gas cooker ventilation holes in the wall of the garden flat must not be blocked as it's the only channel for ventilation for the garden flat. • We have never been informed of the intention to carry out this extension work by the developers (as they have only told us that the property is perfect for their family living). It turns out not. They also never informed us their intention to carry out remodelling work inside the property and how long it will continue). My husband is an elderly man who suffers with epilepsy and one of the main causes of his epilepsy is mental stress and constant strain which has been affecting him and our well-being and mental health enormously. He is retired so he stays home all day and the affect of noise, drilling, banging, disturbance, lack of transparency on the developers" part, constant building rubbish filling the front garden and spilling out on to street is just awful and irresponsible. We don't have anyone to support us and address these issues. • Hazardous building materials , cement powder and all kinds of building dry substance rubbish fills the front garden and polluting the neighbourhood environment without any sign of loading them onto skip. • It's also very concerning that when the developer was spoken to concerning the chimney flues on the roof the developer said "my wife is a solicitor". Does that mean if you have money and your spouse is a solicitor you have an upper hand over people like us?
