### **NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA**

Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Lime (T1) - Re-reduce all aspects of the crown back to previous pruning points (2 - 2.5m re-growth)

1 x Lime (T2) - Re-reduce all aspects of the crown back to previous pruning points (2 - 2.5m re-growth)

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Rowan/Mountain (T3) - Fell to ground level, remove all timber and waste from site and cut stump as level as possible.

1 x Lime (T4) - Re-reduce all aspects of the crown back to previous pruning points, reduce the limb that extends out towards the rear neighbouring property by 1.5m past the previous point to minimise the overhang.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 18 January 2019 and does not wish to object.


- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is

- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. Of particular note is the protection offered to bats, birds and their nests from construction works.
