Informative:

- 1 Permission is sought under Schedule 7 (paragraph 9) of the Crossrail Act 2008 for the Bringing into Use of the Fisher Street Shaft. Planning Forum Note 11 notes that the purpose of such an application is to ensure that the nominated undertaker (Crossrail) has taken all reasonably practicable permanent measures for the mitigation of the effects of the work.

The mitigation is often integrated into the design of the works. In this instance the mitigation is the screening that surrounds the headhouse as it conceals the headhouse and vent.


The submission document submitted as part of this application, outlines all the approvals relevant to this request, this list accords with the Council's records therefore no objection is raised to this Bringing into Use application.
