Reduce overhang by approximately 1.50m Pyracantha: (front verge on Oakeshott Avenue, owned by No.2): proximately 6.00m. Overhanging the road and pavement. Reduce height to approximately 1.20m. Mature Cherry: Approximately 14.00m. Decay noted at approximately 2.50m (road side) and low branches overhang a busy road. Reduce the crown by 25-30%. Thin crown density by 20%. Remove dead wood and raise the crown over the road and pavement by approximately 3.00-4.00m. Reason: General maintenance unless otherwise specified. 6.
