I would like to point out a few inconsistencies in the planning application.

Planning Point 5. There are not 3 A/C units but 4 of them .

Planning Point 22. You cannot see the site from public land . The site can only be viewed from inside my office or the office above .

Clement Acoustic report

I am not a specialist on acoustics but I can see the location where clement acoustics put their noise sensitive receiver is outside of the lightwell where the 4 units have been placed.

I was very concerned when september of 2018 the A/C company installed the units as  
1 Much of the year I open my back window and didn't want to hear 4 large condensers that point towards the window  
2 I suddenly had 4 large unsightly condensers as my new view.  
3 When i asked the installers they told me planning permission had already been granted  
4 when i checked on Camden planning , I saw that planning was for condensers in different

locations

5 The A/C installers promised me 7 times that the building project manager would come to visit my office to explain what was going on but there was never a visit. Emails were also not replied to.

I have two points to make.

I am not sure why they had to place the 4 condensers directly next to my window . I enclose a photo to show you their position.

I question why , when i pay more in business rates than the whole dwelling house pays in council tax , I have to have my view ruined , why cannot the condensers be put in less obstructive position.

I also have concerned about the noise that they will make when all 4 are on and whether it will mean I no longer open my back window in the warmer months

It would have been much better if the project manager /builder had kept me in touch with what was going on as I am not looking to cause a big disagreement with a new neighbour
