1 The site is an Arts & Crafts caretaker's house of 1900, listed grade II and making a positive contribution to the Bloomsbury Conservation Area. The interior retains few original features.

The applicant wishes to discharge condition 4 (Sections, elevation and plan at 1:10 of the new front door) of 2018/5314/L (New single front door with glazed

panel on either side and above, internal partition alteration)

He has provided drawings of an appropriately detailed pair of single-glazed timber doors of Edwardian design visually matching a pair historically known to have existed in the same position.

The proposed works will not harm the special interest of the grade-II-listed building.

Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving the special interest of the listed building, under s.16 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013
