Proposal:

(TPO REF. C6-A1) FRONT GARDEN BY LODGE: 1 x Holly (T9) - Fell to ground level and replace.

The Council has considered your application dated 31 January 2019 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

## Conditions and Reasons:

- This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
  - Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.
- All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)



Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).

Prior to the end of the next available planting season following the completion of works, 1 no. Holly tree (Ilex aquifolium), 12-14cm in girth shall be planted within the same planting bed as the application tree no less than 1m away from any structure unless otherwise agreed with the council in writing. The trees shall be planted and maintained in line with BS 8545:2014.

Reason: To ensure that the replanting achieves a high quality of landscaping which contributes to the visual amenity and character of the area, in accordance with the requirements of policies A2 and A3 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017

## Informative(s):

Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
