It will completely alter the feeling of my property at the back – and will negatively affect its real estate value.</p> <p>One would be very aware of the imposing black clad box when in my garden. It will definitely also affect and be in the view from both my kitchen window and my first floor bedroom window. I don't understand the choice of colour and cladding material.</p> <p>If the colour and material used for this first floor bathroom extension was more in keeping with the Old London Stock brickwork at the rear of the terraced street, or white, it might be less obtrusive.</p> <p>I'm also concerned about damage to party walls as the ground floor extension is built.
