1 Reason for approving details

The proposal seeks to discharge condition 5 of planning permission 2015/5074/P, dated 14/01/2016. Condition 5 required details demonstrating how trees to be retained shall be protected during construction work to be submitted for approval.

The tree protection details submitted are considered sufficient to demonstrate that the trees to be retained will be adequately protected from damage throughout development in line with BS5837:2012. It is therefore recommended that this condition discharged.
