Rear garden

Trees 25, 27, 30, 31 are already felled.

I see the application is to fell 30 and 31 – it seems these were felled without permission.

Front garden

Trees 4, 6, 7 are in good health. I see no reason to fell them.

Tree 19 holm oak does not appear on the plan.

Tree 14 has a useful life of 20-40 years.

It's the only remaining large tree of several – since the new owners bought the house - which overhung our garden.

Generally

41 Frognal was a large but discreet house lying in a beautiful and remarkable woodland setting for passers-by and neighbours to enjoy.

The house will now over-power the view unless its many felled large trees are replaced with similar.
