This does not seem to be mentioned in any of the text accompanying the application, but is shown on a drawing.

I have attached a drawing showing the existing and approved elevations and also the proposed, which is described in the South Hill Park Conservation area statement as, "dominant railings are usually not acceptable".

I think they are inappropriate in this conservation area and should welcome a more open frontage with planting extended from over the bicycle parking to over the front wall. There are many attractive flower boxes in the road, and railings have been refused in the past.
