Please note: Camden Council's Internet connection has been offline since Friday 15th March and is still inoperative due to "outage" problems, so these comments cannot be submitted on your regular web site form. I have been advised by your Planning Department to submit them to you as an e-mail, and I hope you will kindly give them consideration.

On the grounds of public nuisance, I would like to request that this planning application for continued use is only granted on condition that a radical improvement is made to their kitchen extract system at the rear of their premises – one which will guarantee the dispersal of cooking fumes to a level that prevents them being directed over the properties on the south side of Russell Square.

Despite promises to improve their extraction system, the Antalya restaurant has not done so. For years the smells of hot fat and fried food from their grill has been so considerable that it is not possible to open any window on the south side of my property without being invaded by it. The film of airborne grease that accompanies the fumes is equally distressing.

I, and my fellow residents, have faith that if Antalya's planning application could be made subject to the imposition of this condition by Camden Planning officers, the owners might at last take the appropriate action to correct this public nuisance.
