				The freeholder has indicated to the applicant that a licence to alter will be required and permission will not be given for the current roof profile which is considered too great a mass and expanse, reducing the amenity of the flats overlooking it, in particular the rear flat at first floor level which will be further 'hemmed in' by the lantern rooflights. The applicant has indicated a willingness to lower the roof, replace the lantern rooflights with flat ones and change the material from 3 layer felt to something more attractive to look at. We are awaiting revised plans and will control through the licence to alter process. This point is for information in case it is relevant to the planning application.	
				The original application form does not note the interest of the freeholder in the property. We understand an amended form has been submitted but this is not visible on the Camden website.
