Officer comment

Site visits have been undertaken by the case officer and a Planning Enforcement Officer who are satisfied that the works ongoing at the property align with the proposals in the planning application.

Whether or not the garage roof needed replacing is not a planning consideration. The proposed design of the replacement roof needs to be considered and it is considered to be acceptable.

Although the rooflights may be visible they accord with the Council's planning guidance insofar as they are subordinate in size and number.

Site notices were displayed in 3x locations.

Planning permission is not required for internal works to the property.

Issues relating to the fence ion the shared boundary are not a planning consideration.
