The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed hip-to-gable roof extension, by reason of its design, scale and bulk, would appear as an incongruous and visually intrusive alteration, unbalancing the symmetry with the adjoining property at no. 11 Nassington Road, which would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the building, streetscene and South Hill Park Conservation Area. This is contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017 and policies DH1 and DH2 of the Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan 2018.
