The applicant attended the DC meeting hearing 2017/3743/P an insisted that despite the question of minimum room heights being put to him he insisted that no increase would be necessary, the applicant Simon Tart is an architect and if worth his salt would have realised the room height problem he now seeks to amend, simply put if what he proposed was good enough then let it remain as the previous approval.

Any increase in height adds to the cumulative impact of light loss which is a loss of amenity for properties located on Belsize Crescent and this application should be refused, let Architect Simon Tart find the the extra space he is asking for internally from within the building.
