## LANDSCAPE DESIGN STATEMENT

In this revised proposal, we have taken into account the comments made by the panel towards our initial package.

Our design still suggests integrating the existing mature trees into the overall landscape but has increased privacy with a fence made of slatted horizontal trellis panels with minimal gaps to let some light through. The hard landscape materials selected will allow for natural drainage into the planting areas, and materials and colours have been chosen to work with the architects palette.

As you enter the space, the eye is drawn through the central communal area, between multi stem trees and low planting to an attractive focal tree that offers seasonal interest and impact. This tree also provides a link between the 2 individual gardens of the properties. For these, we would like to create screening and privacy without physical barriers; so the lines of clipped, evergreen hedging will follow the architectural lines of the houses, proving natural glimpses across the 2 gardens, without a direct line of site.


The palette of trees and shrubs has been carefully selected to offer a nice contrast to the existing but without looking out of place. We have chosen some deciduous varieties that will offer greater autumn colours whilst letting the light through during Winter months. To help link the planting scheme, some of the proposed new trees will have purple foliage, tying in with the existing *Prunus cerasifera 'Purpurea'*. Key to our selection was also suitability of size for the space :therefore, our selection suggests some small multistem trees and shrubs such as *Stewartia pseudocamilla*, *Acer palmatum 'Osakasuki'*, *Cornus kousa var. chinensis* and *Viburnum x bodnantense*. All of these provide a diverse range of habitats and seasonal amenity value.

We have selected dome shaped native *Taxus baccata* and Spindle to creating a strong visual link between the gardens and provide a foil to the softer herbaceous scheme. The existing mature Hawthorn hedge provides a welcome green backdrop to the new house and will be an integral part of the scheme for privacy.

The herbaceous underplanting will offer a lush, mix of evergreen and deciduous plants to provide an attractive and natural outlook from the houses, following the existing slope towards the fence. The palette of herabceous plants will be able to grow in semi shade conditions without too much maintenance once installed and growing. Flowering season is extended and staggered, offering interest all year round. Everything has been carefully selected to work alongside the existing trees, with minimal root disturbance and to help create a link between the site's mature trees, the proposed ones and the newly built houses.

It is also important to us to help promote diversity in the garden. This rich mix of plants will provide a haven for insects and small animals and birds in the gardens.

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










