# REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

#### Proposal:

(TPO REF. C40-A1) FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Pear (T1) - Reduce by 3-4 feet all round and remove one whole upper branch hanging over the neighbouring building

The Council has considered your application dated 06 February 2019 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

### Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The application tree is mature multi-stemmed pear tree that is located within the Highgate Village Conservation Area.
  - The application is to remove one entire limb/stem and to reduce the remaining crown by 3-4 feet.
  - The tree appears to be in at least fair condition structurally and physiologically, and provides a high level of visual amenity to the residents of West Hill Park.



The tree is considered to significantly contribute to the character of this part of the conservation area.

The application alleges that the branch needs to be removed as it overhanging a neighbouring property. No evidence was submitted to demonstrate the branch is at an increased risk of failure and no reasons to support this were evident when viewing the tree.

The proposed works would significantly harm the visual amenity the tree provides and possibly the long-term health of the tree.

The application has been refused to protect the character of this part of the conservation area and the visual amenity the tree provides.
