Hi Nick,

You will recall I wrote to you about a tree that fell in our garden at the above address a few weeks ago.

I had a report done on the large sycamore and attach a copy produced by Kim Gifford, a tree specialist. He recommends 3-4 metres to be reduced on both stems of the tree. I am advised that I need to apply to Camden to do this work. As there are 2 neighbours fences still to be repaired, is it in order for us to proceed with this work? The tree concerned overhangs where the fences need to be replaced.

I think I mentioned to you in my earlier email that I am in Australia till about 16th April; please can you get back to us as soon as possible on this? I have copied in Kim Gifford incase you wish to speak with him on his advice.
