The vehicle access to the site is a 'blind exit' crossing pavement used by many primary and secondary school pupils on a daily basis. Drivers exiting are forced onto the pavement to get a view of any pedestrians and road traffic beyond the garden fencing and motorcycle parking. This is very dangerous at current levels, let alone with more traffic from the proposed dwellings and unimaginable during any construction. Also parking will be further reduced. The impact of construction on the natural environment and green space is unacceptable. Yet more mature tree loss and green space loss is unacceptable. The visual impact from our building which currently overlooks beautiful mature trees and green garden would be huge. This is an awful idea and should be dropped for the benefit of the community, environment and individuals living in the buildings surrounding the site.
