Thank you for consulting TfL on this application, copy attached. Kingsway forms part of the Strategic Road Network (SRN) for which TfL is the traffic authority. TfL may therefore be concerned about any impact on the performance or safety of the SRN, particularly any impact on bus routes.

Having assessed the proposals, I can confirm that TfL has no comments to make on the development itself but we are concerned that the installation of the equipment may require lifting or crane equipment that could impact on the SRN. I recommend therefore that a construction logistics plan be conditioned if the proposal is permitted.

If the development is permitted I recommend the developer is also reminded of the following:

The footway and carriageway must not be blocked during the development. All vehicles associated with the development must only park / stop at permitted locations and within the time periods permitted by existing on-street restrictions.
