NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A
CONSERVATION AREA

Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1x Rhamnus, 1x Elaeagnus, 1x Dead Cotoneaster, 1x Privet at the back of the rear garden (G1) - Fell to ground level.

- 1 x London Plane (T1) Re-pollard back to previous pruning points. (2-3m re-growth).
- 1 x Sycamore (T2) Re-reduce all aspects of the crown back to previous pruning points. (2-3m re-growth)
- 1 x Horse Chestnut (T3) Re-reduce back to previous points of reduction and retain a healthy amount of furnishing growth in order to facilitate a strong recovery.
- 1 x Holly (T4) Reduce height to match the top of the shed.
- 1 x Purple leaf Plum x 2 (T5) Reduce crown by 2m in order to alleviate some of the stress on the unbalanced crown.
- 1 x *Prunus* (T6) Fell to ground level and dig up stump.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 21 February 2019 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
