The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 22 February 2019 and decided to **OBJECT** for the following reasons:


Reasons for objection:

- 1 The birch is highly visible from the public realm and is considered to make a positive contribution within the street scene.  
The notification alleges that the tree is a contributing to subsidence at the property however no evidence has been submitted in support of this claim.
