In the former two rooms I presently get daylight and sunlight all day, especially from the east in the mornings, and some green outlook, both of which I would loose if these plans go shead as currently outlined. The only natural light I get in the latter two rooms is from these windows. There appears to be a solid wall in the planned side extension, so no way of gaining any 'borrowed' light. I feel the architects plans should show the relative position and size of my windows (3 of them being over 5 ft wide and 3 ft high with clear glazing) plus an estimate of the effects on my right to light. I am also concerned with the apparently extensive alterations at ground level, eg removal of the original outer wall, with regard to the major underpinnings and possible deep pile foundations that this may require, and the effect of these on the foundations of my house and the main drainage and sewers that run down this alleyway, just over a metre away. I would like reassurance that any such structural design is to be approved by the council's structural engineer prior to any approval being given.
