

we can confirm that, based on the details provided to us, ENGIE does have buried plant in the identified area.

Please find attached a drawing detailing the location of apparatus in this in response to the utility request.

The attached drawing gives an indication of flow and return pipework in the area. Drawing 'ENGIE GA Trench Cross Section Layout' gives an indication of a typical buried pipe cross-section. Please note that both drawings give only an indication of the apparatus present and should not be relied upon as definitive notification of ENGIE equipment locations. In some cases GPS surveying techniques have been used, the accuracy of as built drawings is therefore +-50mm from the target position.

Any digging in the vicinity of our pipes should be preceded by the use of pipe detection equipment and should be hand-digging only. These pipes contain hot water under pressure and therefore pose a risk to both contractor personnel and passing members of the public. Some sections of our network will lose integrity if exposed by adjacent works and we therefore request that you inform us if digging within the vicinity of our pipe routes. We ask that you please inform us when you plan to go ahead with the works if you believe they could effect CDE's apparatus.


