Me and my girlfriend used to love coming to blackcaps to enjoy the food. This was like last year 2009 when the atmosphere was nice and the staff were polite. that was back then.

Sadly till this day as of 12/6/10 we rarely go at all. This place has been a dissapointment on several occasions when we have eaten there..

The fish and chips before used to be delicious and the fish was crispy and chunky and great value for the huge portion that you get. Unfortunatly whether it was under the new management or not. the food and service has degraded ..

The fish is now of the same quality as you would find from your local chippy. Greasy, dripping with oil and the fish itself has no texture either anymore.
