(1) They mention a fan at 27 South End makes more noise, 27 Maryon Mews is directly above 27 South End Road and even with the closer do not find this one to be louder than the new one, (2) the mews is a narrow built up street with a mis and two storey buildings, this may lead to unusual acoustics and it is not obvious to me that the refer point chosen in the report is actually the loudest, (3) the level of noise from the unit does vary, I am other the test was done at a time of low noise level.
