Variation of condition 3 (approved plans) of planning permission 2013/1565/P granted 10/07/2013 for the erection of single storey rear extension at lower ground floor level, following demolition of existing rear extension and excavation to create new basement level underneath the extension to single dwelling house (Class C3). As varied under planning permission 2012/6394/P dated 21/01/2013 to reconfigure the staircase to front lightwell, to remove the green roof and to replace the patio doors.
