

The trees are located in the rear garden of 29 Dartmouth Park Hill, NW5 1HP

1 x Elderberry (TG1) - 4 branches overhanging prune back 2m and dead branch overhanging prune back to the wall 2m.

Please note, this tree is now dead and has fungus growth, see photos.

1 x Elderberry (T6) - 6 branches overhanging prune 1m.


1 x Wintersweet (T5) - 4 branches prune back 1-2m to the fence line.

#### 2426:

The trees are located in the rear garden of Tudor Mansion
114 Chetwynd Road, NW5 1DD

1 x Plum (T7) - 2 lower branches prune 0.5m and 4 higher branches prune 2m.

**1 x Plum (T8)** - 3 branches prune 0.75m.



The trees are located in the rear garden of 29 Dartmouth Park Hill, NW5 1HP

1 x Elderberry (TG1) - 4 branches overhanging prune back 2m and dead branch overhanging prune back to the wall 2m.

Please note, this tree is now dead, so all overhanging branches are dead.

1 x Elderberry (T6) - 6 branches overhanging prune 1m.

1 x Wintersweet (T5) - 4 branches prune back 1-2m to the fence line.

#### **Reason for pruning application:**

The dead branches of the Elderberry TG1 are unsightly as covered in fungus and the leaves of the other Elderberry fall into my garden and on the roof of my garden studio, blocking the drainpipe.

#### 2425:

The trees are located in the rear garden of 29 Dartmouth Park Hill, NW5 1HP

1 x Elderberry (TG1) - 4 branches overhanging prune back 2m and dead branch overhanging prune back to the wall 2m.

Please note, this tree is now dead, so all overhanging branches are dead.

1 x Elderberry (T6) - 6 branches overhanging prune 1m.

1 x Wintersweet (T5) - 4 branches prune back 1-2m to the fence line.

I am asking for permission to prune the overhanging branches only.


#### Reason for pruning application:

1 x Plum (T7) - 2 lower branches prune 0.5m and 4 higher branches prune 2m.

**1 x Plum (T8)** - 3 branches prune 0.75m.

Reason for pruning application for the overhanging branches of the 2 Plum trees T7 and T8 at the boundary wall: the leaves and fruit drop in my garden and on the roof of my garden studio, blocking the drainpipe.
