The noise is having a serious impact on my life.	
				The noise has totally destroyed the peace in the Mews and has caused me and many other residents to not be able to sleep due to the noise and vibration levels of the fans which run 24 hours a day.	
				Unfortunately having seen the retrospective planning application it's clear that it isnit totally honest. There are in fact two newly installed very large fans not one as per the planning application.	
				Retail 24 have the ability to turn on either both or one of the fans and either at low or high power and I firmly believe that when the acoustic testing was carried out it wasnit done when both fans were on full power as per the default setting.	
				Therefore don't believe it was a true picture of the normal noise level. Despite this the testing still found that it was too loud hence the requirement for the acoustic coverings. This has finally been built but it unfortunately not built to the specification set out by the council. Therefore it has made no significant difference to the noise levels at all.	
				As residents we would like to be present at the next testing to confirm both fans are making their usual noise and there has been no misdirection. I would also like the acoustic testing to be done from my window.	
				The owner or Retail 24 claims not to be able to hear the fans at all which is surprising and he thinks that it is in our collective imaginations. We are fully in support of the shop however I feel that particularly in a conservation area the owners should follow the same planning rules as all other residents in terms of meeting the standards clearly set out by Camden Council to maintain the area as it should be and not illegally installing commercial units.
