The structure which is currently partially completed appears to have anticipated the proposed installation of gravel by the construction of a parapet of some 3 bricks in height over and above the requirement for standard covering and insulation of a roof. The height of the overall extension with additional raised roof lights which extends the entire length of my garden (the garden at 90 is divided into 2 with flat A only having the section adjacent to the house.) Furthermore the section of land adjacent to the house at 90 is 1 metre lower than the house at 88. The overall impact of the additional parapet and raised sloping skylights in the extension at 88A looms over the adjacent property causing a detrimental impact upon the garden of 90A by causing a significant loss of light and sunshine required to grow plants etc to that which as a keen gardener I previously enjoyed. I no longer get light/sunshine in my garden for any significant time. Nor do I believe that the design of this extension takes into account the impact upon the immediate environment which already suffers from over development.</p>
