The sedum roof at the neighbouring property, also north facing, also enjoys plenty of sun and has flourished.</p> <p>The roof area directly in front of the first floor bedroom where there are 4 slanting roof lights. has a narrower flat roof area adjacent to the main building. Gravel may attract the neighbouring cats, and moss is usually a sign of poor drainage, according to the green roof experts consulted. As green roofs offer some consolation to those flats directly overlooking the extension that had previously enjoyed green garden views, a green roof whether natural or artificial would soften the impact of the extension.</p> <p>Species of sedum recommended for partial shade include: Sedum Album Athoum Sedum Fuldaglut Sedum Green Mantle Sedum Kamschaticum Sedum Sexangulare Sedum Weihenstephaners Gold</p>
