PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS) ACT 1990 (AS AMENDED)

LISTED BUILDING ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY: THE LONDON BOROUGH OF CAMDEN

1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council being the Local Planning Authority for the purposes of Section 38 of the above Act because it appears to them that there has been a contravention of Section 8 of the Act, in respect of the building within a conservation area described below. The Council considers it necessary to issue this notice for the reasons set out in paragraph 4 below.

2. THE LISTED BUILDING

Land at: 68 Highgate Road, London NW5 1PA as shown outlined in black on the attached plan ("the Property").

3. THE CONTRAVENTION ALLEGED

Without listed building consent: the following unauthorised external and internal works to this Grade II listed building:

External

The removal and replacement of single glazed aluminium windows with double glazed timber windows with upvc beading, replacement of timber framed rooflight to main side roof slope with a Velux rooflight and increase in height of existing side infill extension

Internal

The removal of an original staircase and hand rail, installation of plywood and chipboard flooring to first and second floor bedrooms and landings, removal of original doors and architraves, removal of



cornicing to first floor bedrooms, removal of original stone surround and cast iron fireplace in second floor front bedroom

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) The work outlined above has been carried out to this Grade II listed building without the benefit of Listed Building Consent.
- b) The unauthorised external and internal alterations, are insensitive and incongruous and result in a loss of original historic fabric, cause harm to the significance of the listed building by neither preserving or enhancing it special character, contrary to policies A1 (Managing the Impact of Development), D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan. This harm has not been adequately justified in accordance with the NPPF and the external and internal alterations do not offer substantial public or heritage benefits that would outweigh the harm caused

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Within a period of **TWELVE MONTHS** (12) months of the Notice taking effect:

Implement approved remedial works of the unauthorised external and internal alterations to the host dwelling as approved under planning permission (reference: 2018/2820/P) and listed building consent (reference: 2018/5520/L) as outlined below:

- Replace all as-built unauthorised timber windows with upvo beading and existing front and rear windows with timber framed single glazed sash replacements
- Replace as-built Velux rooflight in pre-existing main side roof rooflight aperture with a timber framed conservation style rooflight
- 3. Reduce height of flat roof of side infill extension to match its preexisting height
- 4. Install new balusters, handrail, newel posts and skirting to asbuilt internal staircase to match pre-existing staircase



- 5. Replace as-built plywood and chipboard flooring with salvaged 19th century pine floorboards to first and second floor bedrooms and landings
- 6. Modify as-built window and door architraves to match preexisting examples
- 7. Install cornicing to first floor bedrooms to a similar profile as preexisting cornicing
- 8. Install salvaged stone surround and cast iron fireplace in second floor front bedroom

6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 9 July 2019 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

Failure to comply with a listed building enforcement notice, which has taken effect, can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
