The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed house, by reason of its design, detailing and materials, is

unsympathetic to the surrounding context and does not preserve or enhance the character and appearance of the Belsize Conservation Area contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

- The proposed development, in the absence of a legal agreement requiring the development to incorporate sustainability measures to reduce carbon emissions and minimise use of energy, water and resources, would fail to be sustainable in its use of its resources and meet the challenge of climate change, contrary to Policies CC1 (Climate change mitigation), CC2 (Adapting to climate change) and DM1 (Delivery and monitoring) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
- The proposed development, in the absence of a legal agreement securing the implementation of a Construction Management Plan, would be likely to contribute unacceptably to traffic disruption and road safety hazards and be detrimental to the amenities of the area generally, contrary to policies A1 (Managing the impact of development) and T4 (Sustainable movement of goods and materials) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
