Thank you for sending me details of the above application.

I've lived at the East Wing, The Old Hall , for over 30 years and my garden adjoins that of 3 Bacons Lane.

With regard to the application for works to 3, Bacons Lane I would like to make one comment.

The proposed dining area will immediately abut my garden and the proposed upper level balconies directly overlook it.

As you can see from the attached photo the impact of the proposed works will be significantly reduced , notwithstanding the immediate proximity of the dining room, by the presence of the trees.

Were they not to remain in place or be substantially reduced in height this would obviously no longer be the case and the impact would be very significant. I would therefore ask that any permission be subject to their retention.
