Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 6 x Leylandii (x cupressocyparis leylandii) (G1) (Approximate height 6m) - Fell as close to trees current ground level as possible and leave stump in ground, grind out stump to a minimum of 250mm below trees current ground level and leave all stump arisings to allow for ground settlement and supply and plant 3 x Rowan trees.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 12 November 2015 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.



Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
