Dear Mr Fowler,

I apologise for writing to you directly about this planning application; the planning website was not, however, able to take comments.

I have lived in Downshire Hill with my family for more than 30 years. Over that period traffic and traffic congestion has increased significantly. This is likely to reach unmanageable proportions with an estimated 25% of children being delivered to and collected from school by car.

In addition to the traffic itself, air pollution will be increased not only by the additional school traffic itself but also by other traffic moving slowly and, more likely, often being stationary in and around Downshire Hill. I understand that the proposed school intends to include an air filtration system so as to protect the children from polluted the air which we local residents will suffer as a result of the school's location.

My children are no longer of school-age but it strikes me as bizarre that a new school should open in a place where local children are not eligible for admission. Finally, I understand that there is in any event no necessity for additional school places in the area.

For all of the above reasons I object to the planning application.
