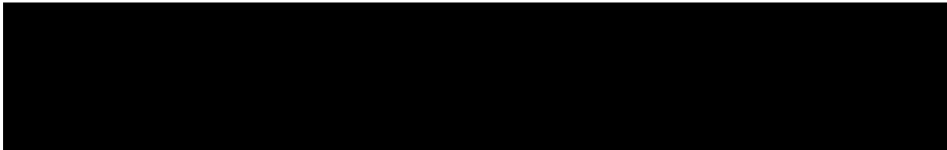

I have been in touch regarding these applications with Elizabeth Kelloway who lives at No 29 Dartmouth Park Hill. She is currently abroad and will only be back briefly early in July. She is 'not worried about the replacement of the dead tree', but 'is concerned about the proposed pruning of her Viburnum and Wintersweet'. In general I do not object to the pruning as long as it is not too severe, but not for the reason of a potentially blocked garden studio drainpipe. If the dead tree is felled, then I support the planting of a native tree which will provide pollen and support much needed biodiversity, in No 27A's rear garden.
