Assessment

The yew is highly visible from the public realm however it is a poor specimen which has been heavily pruned in the past and has a sparse crown. It is planted close to the front of the property in a position which is unsustainable for a tree of this species and will not be able to reach its full potential as it will be subject to intense pruning pressure due to blocking light and proximity to the building. It is not considered expedient to bring it under the protection of a TPO.
