## **Method Statement – 19 Well Road Hampstead**

### **RECORDING, AND PROTECTION OF HISTORIC MASONRY INCLUDING PORTICO & STEPS**

To photographically record masonry to portico and Portland Stone Steps recording defects such as historic structural movement, degradation and soiling.

To remove doors and place in suitable storage and install temporary plywood security doors onto existing pintols/hinges. To protect portico reveals and columns by firstly applying a conservation protecta fleece followed by a marine plywood cladding that will NOT be fixed to the masonry but will be boxed using softwood timbers and compression fitted to avoid intervention or stresss onto the historic fabric.

The steps will be protected firstly by proteca fleece followed by correx sheet and plywood treads and risers again NOT fixed to the masonry. Anti slip strips to be applied to plywood treads.

All protection will be non staining conservation grade materials.
