OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A
CONSERVATION AREA

Description:

FRONT GARDEN: 3 x Silver Birch (T1 - T3) - Fell to ground level.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 07 May 2019 and decided to **OBJECT** for the following reasons:

Reasons for objection:

- 1 The birches are highly visible from the public realm, they are considered to provide a high degree of visual amenity within the street scene and to make a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area.
 - The application states that the trees are causing damage to a wall and paved parking area as well as blocking gutters which is causing damp issues and causing excessive shading.
 - None of the reasons for removal are considered to be sufficient to justify the removal of trees that are worthy of being brought under the protection of a Tree Preservation Order. The wall and paved area can be rebuilt in such a way as to take account of the presence of the trees and prevent/limit future damage.



Leaves can be prevented form clogging gutters by the installation of leaf guards. Shading is not considered to be a robust enough reason to justify the removal a tree that is worthy of being brought under the protection of a Tree Preservation Order.

A Tree Preservation Order has been served to protect the visual amenity the trees provide and preserve the character of the conservation area.

A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.
