

Re: Application PW9802935 at No. 6 Templewood Avenue NW3

Our objections to the above development are as follows:

- 1. Interruption of the line of existing buildings on Templewoord Avenue
  As shown, on the drawing sketch enclosed, the proposed conservatory does infringe on
  the allignment of buildings on Templewood Avenue, and will detract from the uniform
  character of buildings on this unique road in Hampstead.
- 2. Setting a precedence and position of the conservatory
  Approval of the proposed scheme would set precedence for similar alterations to other
  buildings on this road. Particularly because of the position of such an extension which
  overlooks the road side instead of being on the Garden side as usually is the case. Thus
  approval for such an extension will indirectly create a right for others to follow along a
  similar path which would not be beneficial for the enhancement of a Conservation area.

## 2. Roof terrace

The development would create a potential roof terrace for the first floor although most of it is glazed. We are concerned also about the look of the roof, which is seen by most neighbors on floors above ground level.
