Officer's Response:

- 1. It is considered with the context of the vicinity, the design of the window and its location that the window would not detract from the character and appearance of the building in this instance.
- 2. The BIA has been independently audited by structural engineers who conclude that the basement works are safe to carry out with mitigation methods in place.
- 3. Planning permission is subject to a S106 legal agreement for a construction management plan to ensure the works are carried out carefully and considerably amongst other things. The application concludes that the proposal is of high quality design (of what is visible).
- 4. Planning permission is subject to a S106 legal agreement for a construction management plan which would cover these aspects amongst other things.
