"The paper has a particular focus on concerns that exposure to low-level electromagnetic fields might double the risk of childhood leukaemia. It also covers established health effects associated with much higher exposure: Buildings act as effective shields from electric fields, reducing their strength by factors of

between 10 and 100. This is not the case for magnetic fields, which are also the main source of concern from a health standpoint.
