## Re: Installation of two piles at 53 Fitzroy Park, London N6 6JA

I write with regard to the installation of two piles at the above address. Landmark Trees arboricultural consultant David Gardner met with Jalal Yeganeh of Artin Homes Ltd to confirm that the piles were outside the Root Protection Area of all trees and that no trees were damaged during the installation.

I can confirm that the location of the piles is as per drawing 322 - 100 - Piling Setting Out and as such is well outside the RPA of all retained trees and further to this, no evidence of soil compaction was observed during David's site visit.


Given the steep nature of the access into the site from Fitzroy Park, soil compaction or disturbance would have been readily observable, that none is visible in Photograph 2 confirms our assessment that no harm was caused to any retained tree as a result of the installation of the piling.


