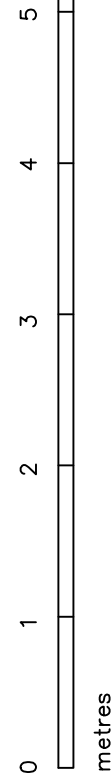

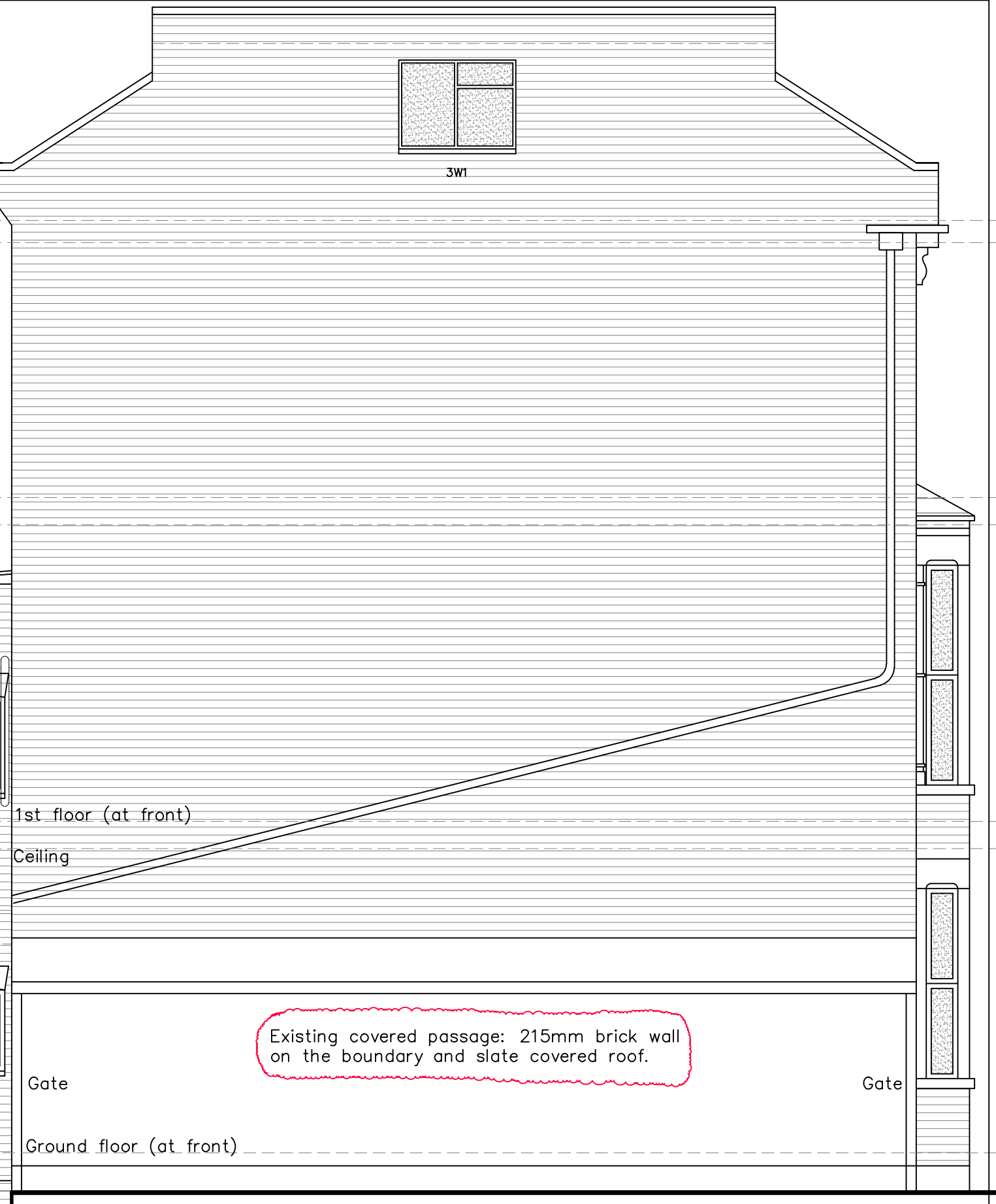

Brick parapet wall

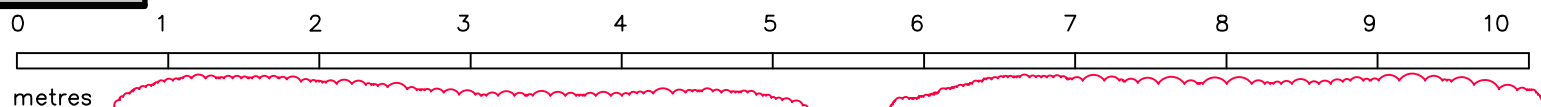
