Tree Planting & After Care Program Channing school 2019

Supply and plant 7 specimen trees & provide aftercare for 3 years to aid establishment.

Aftercare is weekly in the growing season to refill the installed Gators and check they are operating correctly

1x Acer platanoides 20/25 girth 5m - Full standard.

1x Cedrus atlantica 20/25 girth 6m

1x Taxus Bacata 20/25 girth 4m specimen

1x Quercus ilex 20/25 girth 5m -Full standard

1x Fagus atropurpurea 20/25 girth 5m -Full standard

2x Betula pendula 20/25 girth 5m Full standard's

PLANTING SPECIFICATIONS

1:Planting pits to be excavated using mechanical excavator.

2:Drainage outlets to be installed into the pits due to clay substrate

3:Planting pits to be pre fertilised to aid root growth

4:Irrigation gators to be installed to water the trees

5: Install ground anchors

6:Install Bark protection guards

AFTER CARE VISITS FOR 36 MONTHS

Note: Due to the extensive measures taken whilst planting the acute aftercare required will be reduced .

1: Weekly visits during the growing season **March 20th/ October 30th** to re-fill Gators

2:Annual formative pruning to ensure correct form is being maintained.Remove any dead, diseased wood . **October**

3:Annual mulching of the root plate and removal of any ground weeds etc **October**

4:Annual slow release fertilising and organic feeds applied **March**

5:Pest management -Apply insecticides/fungicides should they be required for control. **April- September**

Aftercare for transplanted trees

Tree Number 25: Mountain Ash

Tree Number 26: Whitebeam

(see Arbtech AMs 03 (02) Appendix 1)

1: Supply aftercare for 36 months to assist and monitor the trees as they rejuvenate

2:Install an irrigation Gator to provide consistent watering

3:Monitor trees for disease and infestation

4:Prune as required to encourage new growth

5:Deadwood annually.

6: Apply mycorrhiza annually to aid new root growth . Fertilisers that contain higher levels of nitrate should be avoided until the trees are established.

7: Weekly visits during the growing season **March 20th/ October 30th** to re-fill
