Until effective measures can be put in place to reduce the noise disturbance from the equipment, I urge Camden to refuse this planning application and any subsequent related application.

The disturbance affects an entire terrace of small houses whose bedroom windows are at the same level as the equipment, only a few metres away. Maryon Mews is a very narrow and enclosed street. It has a high density of residential occupation in houses and flats. Noise from external equipment is particularly disturbing at night.

I believe that the equipment still causes too much noise, even after changes to its design and orientation. The noise survey carried out unilaterally for the applicant does not accurately reflect the negative experience that many residents have reported.

If it is not possible to sound-proof the equipment sufficiently or to find a quieter alternative technology, I believe that the unauthorised equipment should be permanently removed.

In the meantime, residents are counting on the local authority to use its statutory powers to make the noise nuisance stop. Please help protect our right to sleep undisturbed.
